

### Exam Formats:

- All Theology Exams are “written” exams delivered digitally (online).
- From the English Department, Women in Literature, Sports in Literature, Mythology, and Media Literacy have project-based exams. All other English exams are “written” exams delivered digitally (online).
- All World Language Exams are project-based.
- All Mathematics Exams (including Financial Literacy) are “written” exams delivered digitally (online).
- All Biology (AP, H and CP), Earth and Space , H Genetics, Environmental Science (AP and CP) are “written” exams delivered digitally (online). All other Science exams are project-based.
- All Social Studies Exams (including Principles of Business) are project-based.
- All Technology Department Exams are project-based.
- All Fine and Performing Arts courses have project-based exams.

Project-based exams utilize a combination of in-class time and time at home to complete the work. Project-based exam due dates are set by the teacher administering the exam.

### Written Exam Schedule:

- Thursday, January 21: Theology 8, 9, 10 AND English 11,12
- Friday, January 22: English 8, 9, 10 AND Math 11,12
- Monday, January 25: Math 8, 9, 10 AND Theology 11,12
- Tuesday, January 26: Science 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 || Math conflicts, make-ups (TWO EXAM TIMES)

The schedule for **January 21, 22, and 25** is as follows:

- Daily schedule: 7:30 – 8:45: “Open Office” for review, questions, etc. (For the exams that day)
- 8:45: First login to exam room
- 9:00 – 10:45: Exam
- 10:45 – 11:30: “Open Office” for the next day’s exam.

To accommodate Science and Math conflicts and make-ups, it is necessary to hold two exams on Tuesday, January 26, 2021, therefore the schedule is as follows:

- 7:30: First login to exam room
- 7:45 – 9:30: First Exam
- 9:30 – 9:45 Break
- 9:45 – 11:30: Second Exam (second Science, second Math, conflicts)

Students are highly encouraged to take advantage of Open Office hours; however, it is not a mandatory login. Teachers will post the Open Office links for online students; those in the building may see teachers personally from 7:30 to 8:45 a.m. on Thursday, Friday, and Monday. There are no Open Office hours Tuesday.

Students taking exams in school **may** enter the building as early as 6:30 a.m., but **must** report to their exam room 15 minutes before the scheduled start of exams. The cafeteria will be open until 8:45 a.m. On the single exam days, there will be “quiet rooms” available for study from 7:30 a.m. to 8:45 a.m. Teachers of that day’s exams will be in their regular classrooms.

Students may leave the building at 10:45 a.m. on single exam days. If you have only the first exam on Tuesday, you may leave at 9:30 a.m. If you are waiting for a ride, you must wait in the cafeteria.
